Leading in Research and Innovation

Our scholars rank among the world's top 2% most-cited scientists, leading award-winning research projects and producing inventions with pending patents. They were recognized at the 49th Geneva International Exhibition of Inventions, receiving the Gold Medal with Congratulations of the Jury for a significant medical discovery. This research breakthrough involves a cutting-edge protein-based platform technology for delivering small-molecule RNA interference (RNAi) therapeutics, which relates to treatments for a range of medical situations, such as cancer, viral infections, and rare diseases. By enhancing early detection and enabling personalised treatments, it has the potential to enhance healthcare practices significantly, benefiting all of us.



Bridging Traditional and Modern Medicine

HKBU is the sole operator of Hong Kong's first Chinese Medicine Hospital. With a focus on medicinal chemistry and drug discovery, our Department aspires to assume a key research role in designing and developing therapeutic and diagnostic agents that bridge traditional Chinese medicine with modern scientific knowledge and life-saving medications.

Commitment to Community Education and Well-Being

Recognising the strong connection between Chemical Science and public welfare, Chemistry scholars are committed to community education initiatives. Our scholars, in collaboration with the Hong Kong Police Force, incorporated narcotic pseudo-scents for public anti-drug events and preventative education seminars in secondary schools, aiming to educate students and the broader public about the adverse impacts of drugs and narcotics. Through these efforts, the Department advances scientific knowledge and contributes to the well-being of the local Community.
